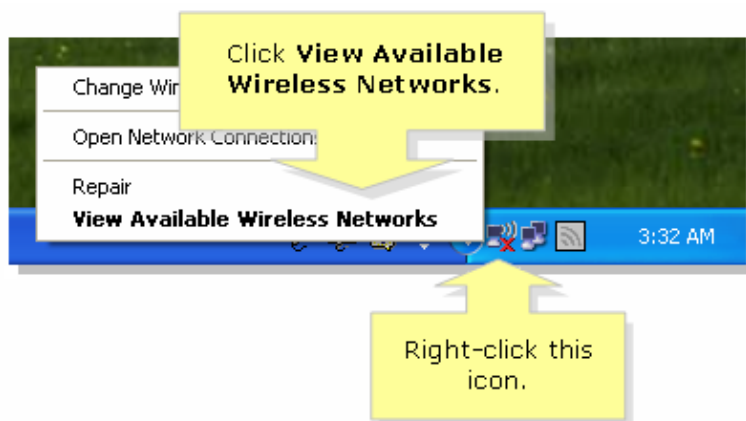

Note: These steps are for Windows XP with Service Pack 2.

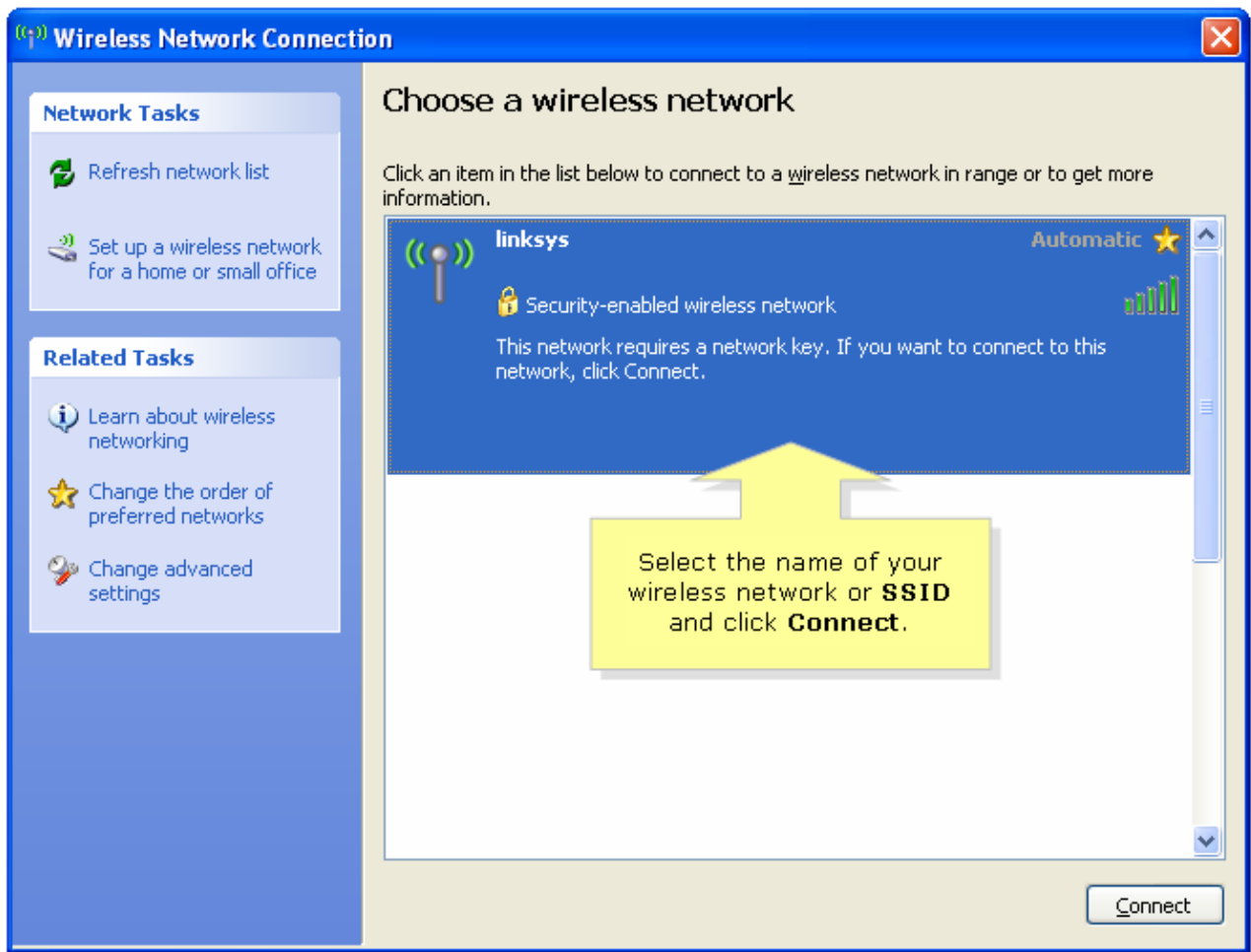
Step 1:

Right-click the **Wireless Network Connection** icon  at the bottom-right of the screen, and select **View Available Wireless Networks**.

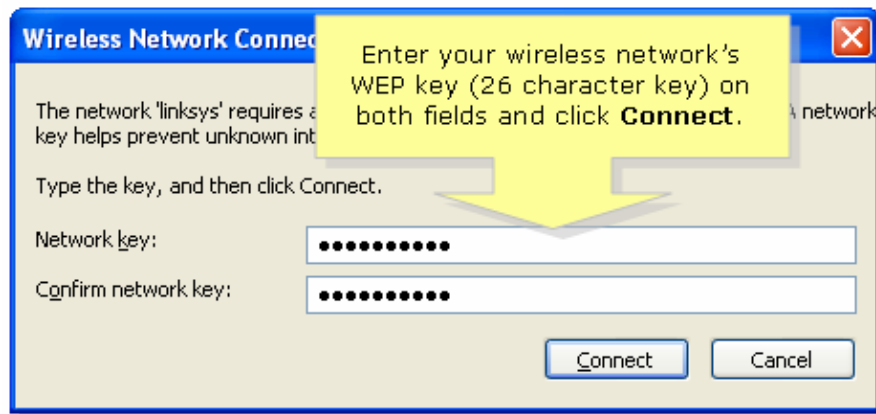


Step 2:

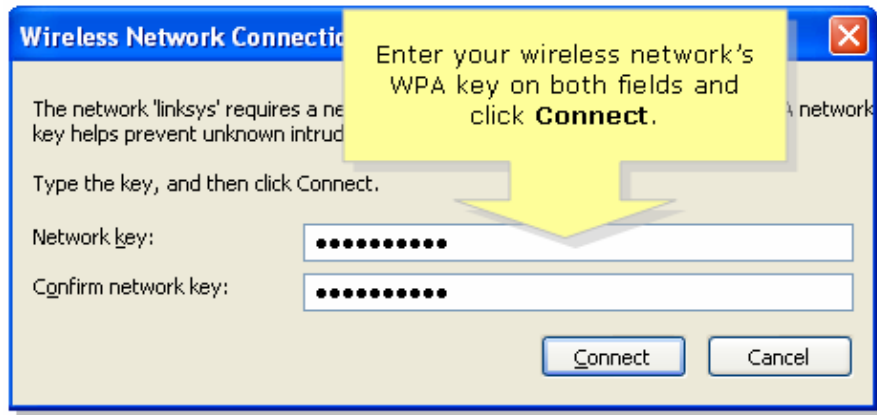
Select your wireless network's name or SSID, and click **Connect**.
