Cisco Unified Communications Manager Prime Collaboration Deployment Information Disclosure Vulnerability

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Summary

A vulnerability in the Prime Collaboration Deployment of Cisco Unified Communications Manager could allow an authenticated, remote attacker to view sensitive data.

The vulnerability is due to insufficient protections of data at rest. An attacker could exploit this vulnerability by browsing to a specific URL. An exploit could allow the attacker to view system *root* credentials.

Cisco has confirmed the vulnerability; however, software updates are not available.

To exploit this vulnerability, an attacker must authenticate to the targeted device. This access requirement reduces the likelihood of a successful exploit.

A successful exploit could allow the attacker to access *root* credentials on the targeted device. These credentials could allow the attacker to gain complete control of the device.

Cisco indicates through the CVSS score that functional exploit code exists; however, the code is not known to be publicly available.

Affected Products

Cisco has released bug ID [CSCuv21819](#) for registered users, which contains additional details and an up-to-date list of affected product versions.

Vulnerable Products

At the time this alert was first published, Cisco Unified Communications Manager Release 10.5(3.10000.9) was vulnerable. Later releases may also be vulnerable.

Products Confirmed Not Vulnerable

No other Cisco products are currently known to be affected by these vulnerabilities.

Workarounds

Administrators are advised to contact the vendor regarding future updates and releases.

Administrators are advised to allow only trusted users to have network access.

Administrators are advised to allow only privileged users to access administration or management systems.

Administrators are advised to monitor affected systems.

Fixed Software

Software updates are not available.

Exploitation and Public Announcements

The Cisco Product Security Incident Response Team (PSIRT) is not aware of any public announcements or malicious use of the vulnerability that is described in this advisory.
