What's New in this Release?

Collaboration Meeting Rooms/Personal Room Support	 Added "Use Personal Room for all my instant meetings" option in My WebEx > Preferences > "Meet Now" Settings, and it is on by default. When enabled, it will start a Personal Room meeting when the user taps "Meet Now." Android supports Personal Rooms in both CMR Cloud and Meeting Center, including lobby management when a room is locked. Host can start a Personal Room meeting. The video address appears on the Info page. On the Join Meeting page, a user can enter a meeting number, URL or username to join the meeting. To join with username, you must be signed in to the site; otherwise it requires the full URL. Lobby: a user is held in the lobby until the host joins the CMR Cloud or Personal Room meeting. Knocking feature: the host is able to lock a CMR Cloud or Personal Room meeting room. The host receives a notification when a user enters the locked room. Knocking feature: Users can still join, but will be kept in the lobby if the CMR Cloud or Personal Room meeting room is locked.
Action Bar Enhancement	 Moved the Record, Q&A and other actions into More actions. Simplified the action bar for the scheduled meeting info page
NBR Bar Enhancement	 Moved the NBR menu item to More actions. NBR status bar will auto fade out after two seconds.
Widget update	 Added "Meet Now" button at top right of widget. User can click "Meet Now" to start an instant meeting.
Q&A Enhancement	 When user is in the meeting, there is a Q&A notification if there is a new question or answer. Tapping the Q&A notification will bring up Q&A page directly.
Active Speaker Enhancement	 User will not see himself in active speaker video; it will show latest speaker when user is talking.
Android L support	Support for Android 5.0 Lollipop.

Known Issues and Limitations in this Release

Personal Room lobby and lock room	The following applies to the Personal Room feature released with WBS29.11:
backward compatibility issue	If you are on a version of the Android app that does not officially support Personal Rooms (below WebEx Meetings for Android version 7.0), as a host you will not be able to manage users in your lobby, even if the attendees are on the latest version of the application.
Telephony service provider audio using the Internet (VoIP) in an Event Center session	The ability to use third party or telephony service provider audio using the Internet (VoIP) in an Event Center session is not yet available.
WebEx Meeting Center meeting types not yet supported	 The following Meeting Center meeting types are not supported in this release: PKI encryption Pay Per Use (PPU)
WebEx products not yet supported	Support Center
Features not yet supported on Event Center	 Starting an event. When a host starts a practice session, mobile panelists and attendees cannot see the shared content or video, and cannot chat.
Features not yet supported	 Screen sharing is not yet supported on Android mobile devices, except for Samsung Galaxy TabPRO and Samsung Galaxy NotePRO. Viewing a streaming video file that is shared in a meeting.
Features not yet supported for users of Cisco WebEx Meetings	 Restart meetings Meetings cannot be restarted from mobile devices. If a meeting has ended, the meeting is deleted from the My Meetings list. Profile pictures Profile pictures are not supported or displayed on mobile devices. Access to meeting for some participants If a host starts a meeting from a mobile device, and a participant who was not originally invited joins the meeting (for example, through a forwarded invitation), that participant does not automatically have access to the meeting space. The host can still share the meeting space with the participant after the meeting. Custom terms of service Custom terms of service are not supported on mobile devices. The only terms of service presented on mobile devices are the standard Cisco WebEx terms of service.
