What's New in this Release?

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| WBS29.11-related features | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anyone can share <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Device supporting sharing will show the Share Screen button highlighted; tapping the button will move the presenter role to that user. ▪ User does not need to “grab the ball” to share content. ▪ Current presenter will not be notified that another user has become the presenter. • Increased frame rate <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Thumbnail video default frame rate increases from 6 fps to 15 fps. • Recurring meeting updates <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ If an exception is made, the app will list the exception and start/join the meeting. |
| Wideband Audio Support | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improved connect to audio using Internet (VoIP) quality with Wideband support (Requires WBS 29.8+) |

Resolved Issue in this Release

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| Video and sharing orientation | On Z10 and Z30 devices, if a user starts video and then changes the device orientation to landscape, the desktop share still appears in portrait mode. |
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Known Issues and Limitations in this Release

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| Video issues on Z30 devices | If you start your video, start screen sharing, and then stop screen sharing in a meeting, you may not be able to start your video again in the meeting. Resolution: Restart your device. |
| Joining a meeting before the host | <p>If the option “Attendees can join X minutes before start time” is checked but X is set to zero when the host schedules a meeting, you cannot join the meeting from the My Meetings list.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The video icon is disabled if you join before the host. Video becomes available when the host joins the meeting. |

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| WebEx Meeting Center meeting types not yet supported | <p>The following Meeting Center meeting types are not supported in the app:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PKI (Public Key Identifier) encryption • Pay Per Use (PPU) • Personal Conferencing |
| WebEx products not yet supported | <p>The following products are not yet supported in the app:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cisco WebEx Training Center • Cisco WebEx Event Center • Cisco WebEx Support Center • Cisco WebEx Meetings Server |
| Features not yet supported for users of WebEx Meeting Center and Cisco WebEx Meetings | <p>The following features are not yet supported in the app:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing content from a meeting on your mobile device • Playing back a meeting recording • Collaboration Meeting Rooms or Personal Rooms in the cloud • Collaboration Meeting Rooms (hybrid) • Viewing a streaming video file that has been shared in a meeting |
| Features not yet supported for users of Cisco WebEx Meetings | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Restart meetings Meetings cannot be restarted from mobile devices. If a meeting has ended, the meeting is deleted from the My Meetings list. • Profile pictures Profile pictures are not supported or displayed on mobile devices. • Access to meeting for some participants If a host starts a meeting from a mobile device, and a participant who was not originally invited joins the meeting (for example, through a forwarded invitation), that participant does not automatically have access to the meeting space. The host can still share the meeting space with the participant after the meeting. • Custom terms of service Custom terms of service are not supported on mobile devices. The only terms of service presented on mobile devices are the standard Cisco WebEx terms of service. |



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
